- A. Approval of January 2021 Minutes: Motion by Lorne/NOCYK, second by Zach/KOZSH to approve the January 2021 meeting minutes; motion carried.
- B. Treasurer's Report: Dee/KB0CGK gave a detailed update of expenses and income since the last report in February 2020. The checking account balance as of this meeting is \$252.70; the savings account balance as of this meeting is \$22,238.63. Motion by Zach/K0ZSH, second by Lorne/N0CYK to approve the report; motion carried.

C. Guests: None

Committee Reports

- 1. Technical: Mark/NOFAZ reported that he and Randy/KCOCAU will be meeting with a Vikor representative on February 24th at the 85 tower site to determine the work to be accomplished. As soon as he receives a quote for the work, he will contact the Club President.
- 2. Skywarn: Zach/K0ZSH reported that, due to the COVID pandemic, there will be no Skywarn training this year. Anyone wishing a refresher can access the NWS website for more information. There will be no NWS activation during Severe Summer Weather Awareness Week in May. The NWS office is not open to the public, so there will be no net controllers required this summer; if you have severe weather to report, you are encouraged to contact NWS directly. If you wish to send videos/photos make sure to include your name and call sign, and give permission to them to use the videos/photos. Zach provided a list of the duties he has performed, and is resigning his Skywarn liaison duties effective February 23rd, 2021. Club President Mike/KE0ESG thanked him for his 11 years of service as the Skywarn coordinator.
- 3. VE Testing: Bob/NOTC reported on the testing and FCC updates:
- Social Security Numbers will no longer be used for identification - a Federal Registration Number (FRN) will be required instead.
- The FCC is not accepting paper 605's
 all actions must be completed via the internet.

- The FCC will also implement a fee of \$35 for most licensing actions sometime this summer; he does not know if ARRL will have a separate fee yet.
- All licensees will be required to provide an email address to the FCC.
- 4. Net Control: No report

Old Business

- 1. CDARC Hamfest: Jeff/K0CMS gave an update on upcoming Hamfest preparations. The ARRL Forum is tentatively cancelled. There will be no early access to the BSC Career Academy on Friday night. Club President Mike/KE0ESG provided a table setup diagram which effects social distancing requirements. Mark/NOFAZ asked if there was any idea how many people may show up for the event; that is unknown since the Club is not requiring preregistration. A list of donated equipment was presented to the members to determine what the Club should keep and what should be offered for sale at the Hamfest; motion by Zack/K0ZSH, second by Lorne/N0CYK, to offer the four pieces of Drake TR7 equipment (TR7 transceiver, remote VFO, microphone and power supply) for sale as a package with the starting price at \$800, with a minimum price of \$500 which will not be acceptable until after 11:00 am on the day of the Hamfest; motion carried. The members also consented to sell the Club's Kenwood TS-140 along with the donated Kenwood phone patch and station monitor as a package with a starting price of \$350. The Drake SP75 speech processor will be sold separately with an asking price of \$150. The Heathkit frequency counter will be sold separately with an asking price of \$100. One Yaesu microphone will be sold separately with an asking price of \$100.
- 2. Silent Key: Bruce Kocher/KI0JG passed away recently. Motion by Mark/N0FAZ, second by Randy/KC0CAU, to send a \$50 memorial in Bruce's name to ARRL; motion carried.
- 3. Elections: Jeff/KØCMS gave an update on the upcoming CDARC elections. The election will take place at the March 23rd meeting. Several individuals have already expressed intent to run for office. Anyone wishing to run for a Club office should contact Jeff at KØCMS@ARRL.NET, or call 701-527-8918. A list of those running for office will be compiled at the March 9th Executive Board meeting and

If you are planning on testing for your <u>first</u> Amateur Radio License, go to the following website and obtain a Federal Registration Number (FRN) first, and bring it with you to the testing session:

https://apps.fcc.gov/coresWeb/publicHome.do

(Note: if you already have a license, you already have a FRN; you do not need to register again)

VOLUNTEER EXAMINERS TAKE NOTE!

All ARRL-accredited Volunteer Examiners (VE's) must participate in at least one testing session every 5 years for their credentials to remain valid.
